



# 2008 Leapfrog Hospital Survey for Michigan

Results as of September 30, 2008

# Summary

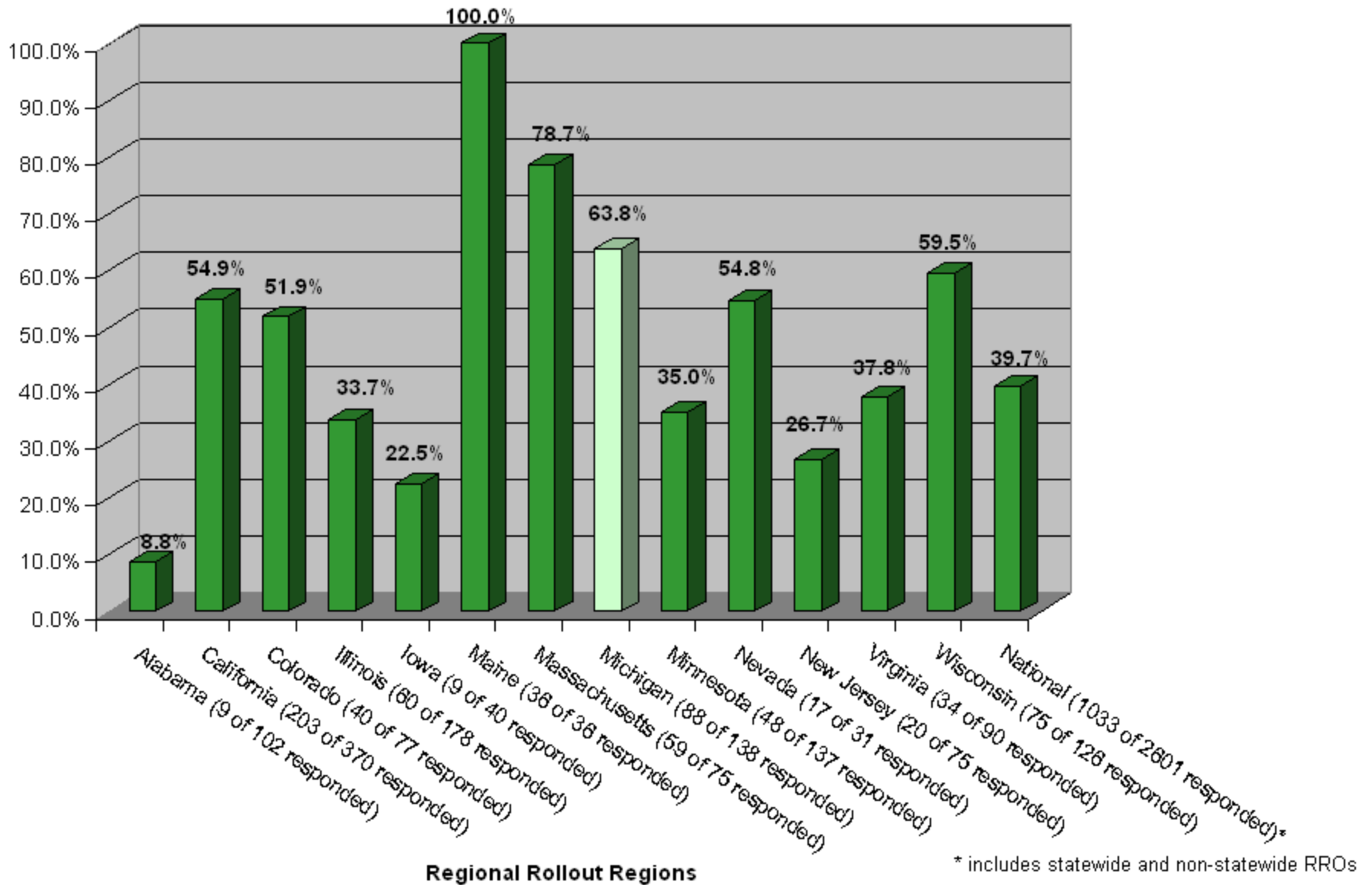
- The deadline for reporting first results was June 30, 2008. The survey remains open until late March 2009 for hospitals to update or enter responses.
- As of September 30, 2008 there were 88 participating hospitals out of 138 eligible – a response rate of 63.8%.
  - The highest response rate was among group 2 hospitals (large urban hospitals with teaching programs). 81% of these hospitals participated in the survey so far.
  - Smaller hospitals are participating at a higher rate compared to previous years.
- There was good representation in all regions, especially in Southeastern Michigan.

# Leaps

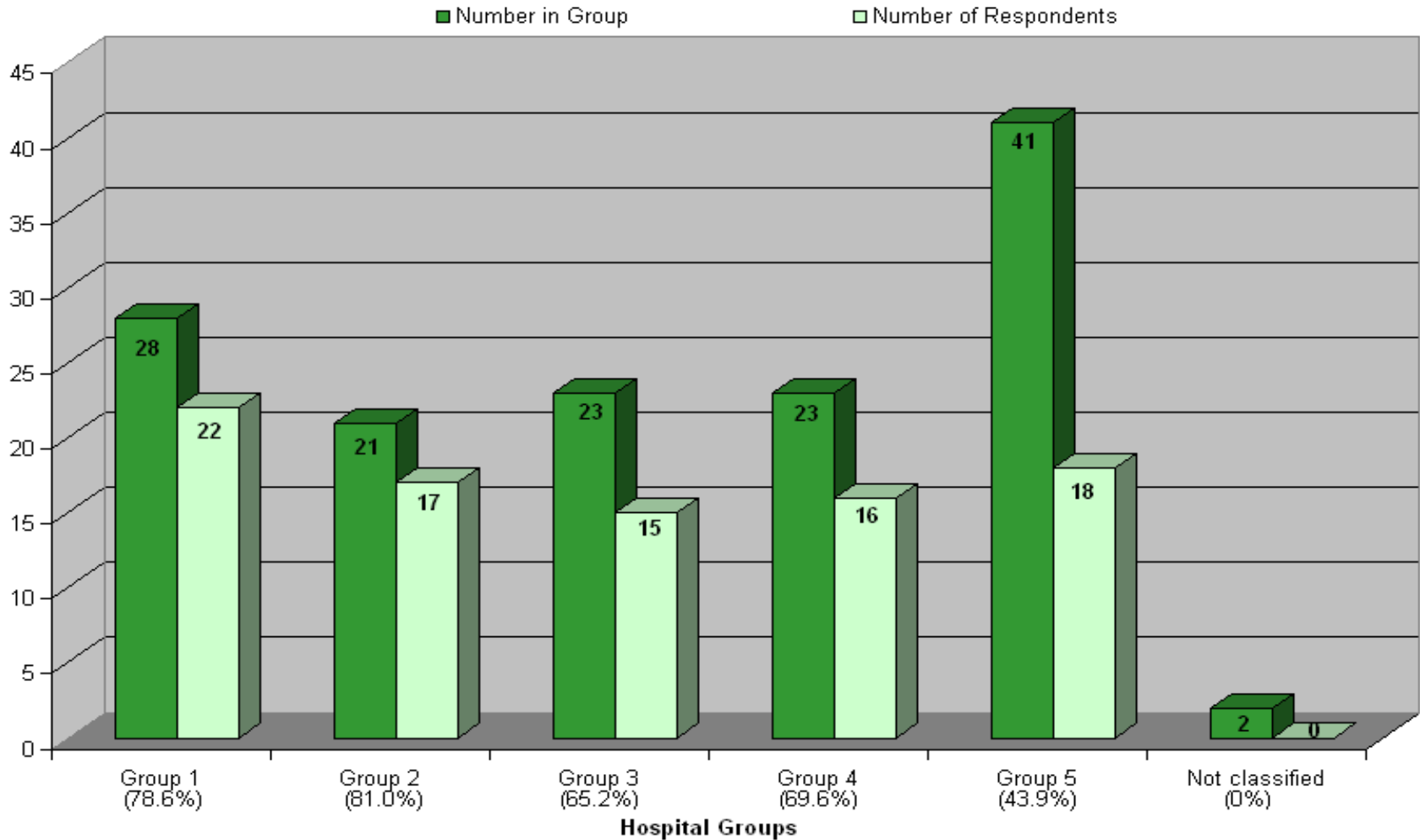
The Leapfrog Hospital Survey is divided into four areas or “Leaps” of hospital quality and safety practices:

- **Computer Physician Order Entry (CPOE)** which measures use of computerized prescription systems
- **Evidence-Based Hospital Referral (EBHR)** which identifies hospitals with the best results or extensive experience for selected high-risk conditions and procedures
  - coronary artery bypass graft
  - percutaneous coronary intervention
  - abdominal aortic aneurysm repair
  - aortic valve replacement
  - pancreatic resection
  - esophagectomy
  - bariatric surgery
  - High-risk deliveries
- **ICU Physician Staffing (IPS)** which measures staffing of intensive care units with trained specialists
- **Safe Practices Score (SPS)** which measures 13 of the NQF’s 27 other Safe Practices developed by national consensus in the following groupings
  - safety culture
  - communication among health care workers
  - doctor and patient communications
  - prevent infections
  - prevent medication errors
  - prevent other complications and mistakes

Group 1: Hospitals with more than 325 beds and large teaching mission.

Group 2: Hospitals with more than 325 beds and small teaching mission.

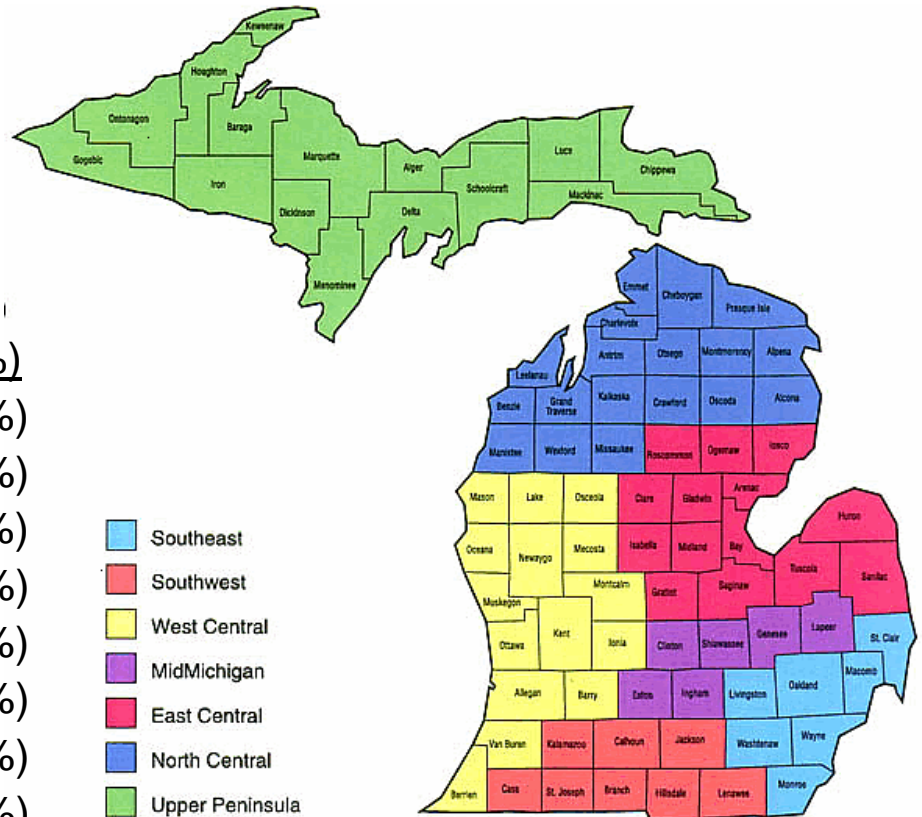
Group 3: Hospitals with more than 150 beds, but less than 325 beds.

Group 4: Rural hospitals with less than 150 beds.

Group 5: Rural Hospitals with less than 100 beds and critical access hospitals.

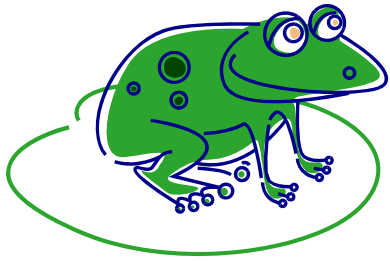
Not classified: includes non-acute and specialty hospitals.
