Net farming income (with possible subsidies added into for U.S. government agriculture)

Pt. Care lounges main floors

Like social/recreational [non (R-OH)] functional activity/cultural rooms [M.D., prescribed]

1. Country & western music
2. Motown & hip-hop music
3. Pop Rock
4. Classic rock
5. Alternative rock
6. Orchestra Classical music
7. Opera music
8. Wedding & Big band music

Also allow visitors, paying patrons, etc., to patronize hospital pt. care lounges, strict policies, [M.D. → pt. care influence]

Security

Revenue emphasis: costs are 90% of (R.).

Net profits are 10% of (R.), for ea. Lounge, (\$'s) funds are for additional [M.D. → Pt. care].

Bars → see food services and drinking places

of income tax returns, bus. Receipts and net income by type of business and industry.

Food service and drinking places: (non → R – OH) as ordered by MDS.

+ health care & social assistance to be inclusive in mgmt/M.D./Pt. decisions.

3. Bus. Entities & hospital entities

U.S. \$300 billion in bus. Receipts.

Solution: Mich., lobbying, U.S. congress

Medicare premiums paid by every worker/household, established med./health coverages,

Added-on with priv./gov't. insurances.

U.S. congress to set laws; yr.

All prems. – 100% includes mkt. security \$ mad

All total expenditures of M.D. → pt. care & all staffs(s)

Yrly. Total net balance = 3% Medicare fund, surplus as a safeguard.

Ex. Used for additional Med. cases, mkt. securities (up to 1 yr.), investments (> 1 yr.), M.D. → pt. care

Incentives: Ex. Preventative care, added admin. costs
